### **Summer Financial Aid Eligibility Requirements**

You must have a processed 2019-20 [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) on file with the Office of Financial Aid to be considered for summer financial aid.

If you are eligible for a Federal Pell Grant during summer, we will review your eligibility. If you have been awarded your full-time initial scheduled Pell Grant during 2019-20, you must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours in summer to receive an additional Pell Grant award from the 2019-20 academic year and disbursement of those funds may be delayed based on your enrollment. To receive Pell Grant from 2019-20, all outstanding requirements for that year must have been submitted to be processed by the Office of Financial Aid. Receipt of Pell Grant will be counted toward your maximum 600% lifetime Pell Grant usage limit.

You must meet all other eligibility requirements, including admission to an eligible academic program and meeting [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#). You must be registered for one or more courses during the 2020 summer enrollment period for your summer financial aid request to be considered.

To complete a Summer Loan Application, you must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours. Eligibility could be limited if you requested Max Loans in the Fall/Spring semester. Click this link to continue to the loan application
